Interstate 85 north to Clairmont Road (exit 91), left on Clairmont Road. At the 3rd traffic light, turn right on Century Blvd. Hotel at end of blvd. on the right.

From north:

Interstate 85 South to Clairmont Road, right on Clairmont Road. At the 3rd traffic light, turn right on Century Boulevard.
